Finer Music (KISW): Included in the afternoon's works are "Pictures at an Exhibition," "The Seasons," Giuliani's Guitar Concerto and piano works by Beethoven. Symphony of the Air (KXA): The Philharmonica orchestra performs "Midsummer Night's Dream" and Weber's Konzertstuek.
